The mission of The Arc of Hilo is to improve the quality of life for people with developmental and other disabilities, who reside on Hawaii through educational, vocational and skill training as well as employment and residential opportunities. The Arc of Hilo is the largest employer of persons with disabilities on the Island of Hawaii.

Employment Training Services trains persons with disabilities in competitive employment skills, job interview skills, job readiness, and personal grooming and resume preparation. Commercial Services, a part of Employment Training Services, offers training and employment for clients in our community in janitorial, grounds keeping, laundry and greenhouse nursery production services.

Residential Services, through affiliates the Hilo Arc Housing Corporation No. 1 and Hale Ulu Hoi III, maintains three apartment buildings for low income people with disabilities who are capable of living independently.

Client Support Services provides several programs which supply person-centered educational, vocational, independent living skills training, personal care and supervision to persons with developmental or other disabilities.

Redemption Services, in cooperation with the County of Hawaii, offers training and employment opportunities for persons with disabilities in recycling centers throughout the Island of Hawaii.

The Arc of Hilo was incorporated in 1954 as a tax-exempt charitable organization under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Board of Directors is composed of concerned community-based volunteers.
